3D printing tool

Often hardware-based and provided by the hardware's manufacturer

Pros

Costs

- Generally free

Features/usability

- Excellent results when used with specific printers
- Provides accurate time and materials estimates

Cons

Features/usability

- No accounting integration
- No submission tool
- No automatic tracking
- No upfront cost estimation
- No print job notifications/updates

Adoptability

- Vendor-specific and not ideal for mixed environments with CNC and laser cutting

Cons

Features/usability

- No security or confidentiality
- No user-friendly interface/workflow for end users
- No upfront cost estimation

Adoptability

- Doesn't scale

Third-party workflow tool

Enterprise solution to manage entire FabLab fleets

Pros

Features/usability

- Tight integration to printers
- Advanced capabilities, e.g. using cameras to track job progress visually
- Great for optimizing internal workflows

Cons

Costs

- Very expensive, and often costed per job (not at all ideal for large user bases, e.g. universities)

Features/usability

- Lacklustre user interface
- No accounting/charging capabilities

Adoptability

- Commonly vendor-specific and not ideal for mixed environments with CNC and laser cutting
